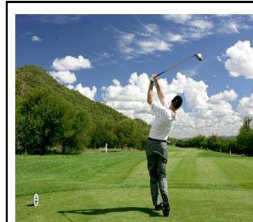

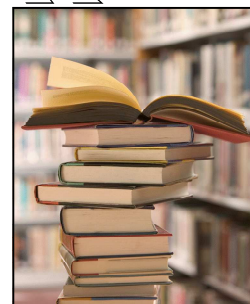
OPPORTUNITIES FOR SERVICE . . .
