GEM, Germany

In January 1990 I was appointed to serve with Greater Europe Mission. Two months from now I will have been with GEM for 20 years. The last 5 years have been a change from the initial 15. I came onboard with EuroTeam to assist with the TEFL (teaching English as a foreign language) department and to supervise teams in this outreach. As time went by, I transitioned into the administrative role of coordinating the various teams that go out and more recently have been on the leadership team for EuroTeam. As we get to the end of 2009, would you pray about becoming a regular prayer warrior or a financial partner? With the high value of the euro against both the Canadian and American dollar, some months can be difficult to cover the various costs of living here. As a new year approaches please pray for us here at EuroTeam. Our goal is to have 20 teams a year in service in some way.
