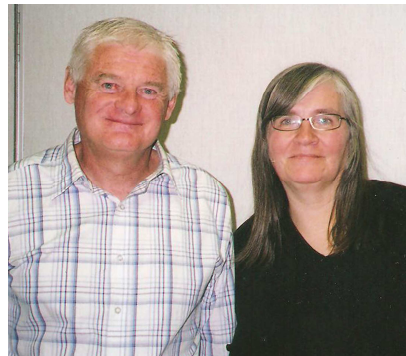
APARTMENT NEEDED
